



Coordinated Family Support

What is Coordinated Family Support?

Easterseals Southern California developed this new program in response to input from families about the lack of available services for adults with developmental disabilities who chose to live in their family home. The goal is to help the individual and their family access needed services and support so they can continue to live at home. Easterseals Southern California will provide support that is personalized, in their language and in a way that is respectful to their culture.

Individuals using this service might require specialized medical and/or mental health attention and may need support to access care. They may be living with aging caregivers who need assistance with understanding and navigating services and/or setting up back up, long term plans of care.

Individual Support Includes

- Development and implementation of a personal support plan
- Regular face-to-face contact with Easterseals staff
- Coordination of service providers to promote each individual's self-advocacy skills, health and safety in their chosen living arrangement and increase awareness of the person's needs and diagnosis

Criteria

- 18 years of age or older
- Living at home with family
- Determined eligible by Regional Center
